Editions of the fifteen prayers which St. Birgitta is sometimes said to have used, sometimes to have written, though they can hardly be by her.

The list was rather complete on 2001-11-08 as far as the earliest editions and the Dutch editions are concerned, and was full but not complete as regards French editions. The sections on *Horae* and Primers from England were added and corrected 2002-02-25; French *Horae* listed in Lacombe and Rézeau were added 2002-11-13. Many editions must still be missing (e.g. *Horae* from Germany and Polish editions).

According to Klemming, p. 59/235, the Fifteen Oes in Latin are included in several eds. of the *Mirabilia Rome* (or *Historia et descriptio urbis Romae*) printed in Rome 1480–1500. In fact, editions of this work appeared already in the early 1470s, and it was also often printed in German and, to a lesser extent, in Dutch, French and Italian. We have been able to inspect one of the German editions, ISTC im00609400, which contained a brief mention of St Birgitta in connection with the description of S. Paolo Fuori le Mura but not the Fifteen Oes. Available catalogues have affirmed the presence of the Fifteen Oes only in the following edition of the *Mirabilia Rome*:

However, it seems as if early editions of the Fifteen Oes in Latin (for which see above) were often bound with either the *Mirabilia Romae* or the *Indulgentiae ecclesiarum principalium urbis Romae* or both, often also with other

prayers that could be useful to pilgrims – especially from 1490 until the Jubilee Year of 1500, when a culmen was reached. It may be that Klemming was referring to such volumes.

Horae or Primers of the Salisbury and York Uses

The *Horae* or Primer was a prayer book with very diverse content, the original core of which was a set of ‘Hours’, i. e. a simplified version of the Divine Office. It was a very popular book in England; Hoskins (pp. xxiii–xxviii, liii [corr.] and 1–81) lists 246 editions published c. 1478–1558. The last traditional Primer according to the use of Salisbury (or ‘Sarum’) was published in 1558. However, reformed primers of various kinds started to appear in 1534 and continued to be published until 1825; and a revised Catholic Primer (*Officium B. Mariae Virginis, nuper reformatum, et Pii V Pont. Max. jussu editum*) appeared in 1571, was published in English in 1599, and continued to be published in new editions until 1867 at least.

The early Sarum and York Primers contained prayers in Latin with an occasional supplement in English. In 1535 editions started to appear which were bilingual, or in English only. It seems that the Latin editions regularly contain the Fifteen Oes in Latin – and also ‘The short prayers taught by our Lady to St. Bryggyte’ in Latin (for which see **Liturgical Texts**) – while the bilingual and English editions regularly contain the Fifteen Oes in both English and Latin, or in English only (for which see the section of publications in English further below).

The list of Primers given here does not attempt to be exhaustive; apart from the first four items, where the presence of the Fifteen Oes has been specifically ascertained, it includes only those editions which mention the Fifteen Oes in title or colophon. Unless otherwise stated, references to Hoskins are by number, not page. Cf. (R)STC 15876–15985a.5 ...

Hoskins seems to imply that the Fifteen Oes regularly appeared in Primers in English 1534–58, but his information is patchy and it is also clear that several Primers of this period consciously rejected the Fifteen Oes. No attempt has been made to research the subject independently; the list below incorporates only those Primers which in reliable bibliographical sources are explicitly said to contain the Fifteen Oes in English.
